Re: Paul Stymelski's offer of bench for city park

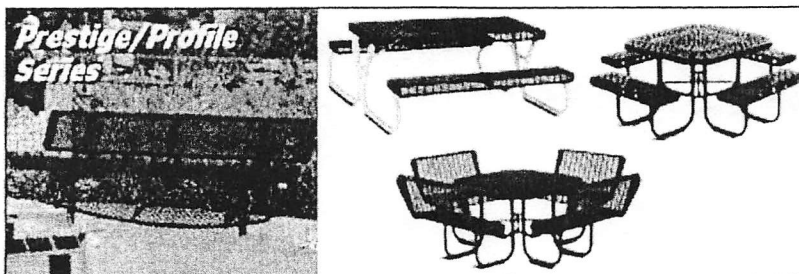
OK site by staff

Mr. Stymelski is asking you to consider his placing a picnic table with attached benches in place of the park bench that he proposed at your last meeting. After viewing the area he feels a picnic table and bench would be more beneficial to Chetco Point users than the bench would be.

Mr. Stymelski is proposing donating a 6' table like the rectangular one shown in the picture below. It is manufactured by the same company as the bench, Wabash Valley.

Mr. Stymelski is proposing the table be placed on a promontory of land between the path to the beach and an old fence that could be on a property line on the westerly side. As this information was given to the Community Development Department on Wednesday, January 23, city staff has not been able to review the site to determine if it compliments Chetco Point as a whole. Staff will review this proposed site and have a report at your next meeting.

As the table is very heavy Mr. Stymelski would like to have it shipped directly to the Wastewater Treatment Plant/Public Works Shop Compound so he does not have to move it from his home in Smith River. City staff will review this request and include recommendations on this in their staff report.
