MINUTES CITY OF BROOKINGS PARK & RECREATION COMMISSION July 28, 1971

Meeting called at 8:00 p.m. at City Hall. Present were Allan Ettinger, Chairman; M. Hoppin, Del Oliver and Lee Hansen.

Commissioner Gene Colegrove was present to talk about a park and recreation area. County has $3\frac{1}{2}$ acres located near a 2 acre city-owned area. Peter Kiewit Sons will clear property and city is being asked to dig trenches for pipelines.

A pool 45' X 75' will cost \$54,000, complete with heating apparatus. Commissioner Colegrove talked to Ed Riley of Coos Bay about price of pool and Bureau of Outdoor Recreation (State of Oregon) about assistance in financing. Pool can probably be financed with state funds, with \$22,000 available by January 1, 1972 (\$11,000 in fiscal 1971 and \$11,000 in fiscal 1972) and he hopes balance can be provided by county next year.

The Commission talked about requiring users to buy season tickets to make pool self-supporting, so it won't be a burden to the taxpayers.

Tennis courts and two ball diamonds would be included in this same complex.

Park would be cooperative with both city and county cooperating. Details will be worked out later.

City must approve the park being within the Brookings city limits (by resolution).

A committee recently contacted Mrs. Stout to see if she could help provide funds as part of the grant she has already placed in escrow for the city. She is taking the suggestion under advisement.

Meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
