

MINUTES
CITY OF BROOKINGS
PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION
March 29, 1972

Meeting called to order at 7:30 p.m. Present: Chairman Allan Ettinger, Marshall Hoppin, Dellis Oliver, and H. Lee Hansen. Also present were Council members Wilma Kemp, Rush Long, Cal Gorte, and Mayor Williams.

Minutes of March 15, 1972, meeting were read and approved unanimously.

MOTION that "Marine Park" section of the minutes of meeting of March 15, 1972, be reworded after Ron Westernen returns and can enter the discussion. Apparently this was based on some misinformation. Motion carried.

Mr. Rush Long was appointed Park Commissioner on the City Council. He said he would be able to attend most meetings of the Park Commission and would like to receive meeting notices each time.

MOVED by Marshall Hoppin that we ask the Brookings-Harbor Jaycees to chair our park playground equipment purchase program and to contact local organizations to purchase playground equipment for our two parks. Motion seconded by H. Lee Hansen and carried. They will be asked to meet with us at our next meeting if they accept, so that we can work out a plan of action. Mr. Hoppin will contact the Jaycees.

Budget discussed. Because of lack of information the Commission decided to hold up until next meeting, April 5. Elmer Lee may be well enough to attend and give us his findings.

Council members expressed interest in our playground equipment program and were shown catalogs with photos of the various items.

Mr. Long suggested that one copy of Park Commission minutes be sent to the City Council after each meeting. Chairman Ettinger thanked Council members for their interest in attending this evening's meeting and suggested they do it oftener.
