## MINUTES CITY OF BROOKINGS PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION SEPTEMBER 5, 1974

Elmer said a backhoe will help in setting fence post forms in the new gravel. John Lacy volunteered to contact Gary Wimberley to ask him to use his backhoe while members of this Commission set the forms.

Elmer will have the city engineer put stakes in spots where each post will stand. Members will build forms at the Oliver home in their spare time during the next week. When they are ready, a day will be set for commission members to get together to set the forms, and the posts later.
