

MINUTES
CITY OF BROOKINGS
PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION
JUNE 5, 1975

Meeting of Parks & Recreation Commission was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Members present were Lee Hansen, Bruce Kent, Al Phillips, Clarence Fix, Ellis Watkins, and Del Oliver. Parks Commissioner Jack Ross and Elmer Lee, Public Service Coordinator, were also present.

Mr. Brick Westhusing, grade school teacher, was present and brought up the question of the possibility of a community center building. Discussed at length the possibility of something of this nature being established in the City of Brookings.

Minutes for meeting of May 2, 1975, read and approved.

Discussed record of swimming pool for the month of May. Revenue received, \$1,607.00; expenses \$1,852.00 for operating 20 days out of the month. Discussed problems at swimming pool about lack of water pressure to use showers.

Mr. Watkins asked Elmer Lee for assistance to clear rubble around pool area so plants can be put out. Two local nurseries are willing to donate shrubs for the pool area.

Prices on concrete blocks for restrooms in Easy Manor Park are less than previously noted, but all other materials are increasing in price according to Mr. Lee. Will try to get top soil for the Easy Manor Park and get it spread so Park can be planted with grass. The group agreed that grass will make a better play surface than sand.

The Commissioners authorized Elmer Lee to purchase material and supplies for Easy Manor Park.

Discussed possibility of raising matching funds to purchase equipment for Park playgrounds.

Meeting adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
