There was discussion about the new swimming pool heater. Marshall Ferg stated that it would take about three weeks to receive the heater. The installation would take about a day. The discussion then centered around a pool cover to reduce heat loss. Marshall Ferg stated that Jeanne Russ, Pool Supervisor was to get the information on pool covers.

IV. EASY MANOR PARK

It was brought up that a new sign identifying the park had been installed by the City.

Janet Patterson and Sharon Walker who represented the Jaycee'ettes inquired if the Parks Commission would be receptive to a donation of tables and benches to the Park. The Commission was agreeable to the donation.

V. REST ROOM CONSTRUCTION

The Commission was given a progress report on construction by Marshall Ferg.

VI. TENNIS COURTS

The order by the Council to turn off the lights was discussed. The Commission felt that the lights should be on during the summer months until 10:00 p.m. A coin machine to operate the lights was discussed. A problem with a coin machine would be vandalism. Also discussed by Steve Buckley, was a coin operated gate lock to the courts to help raise revenue and stop vandalism. Mr. Buckley was to investigate the possibility.
