

Azalea Park Activities Sub-Committee
3-23-92 meeting notes

Goal of the sub-committee is to provide the City Council with a summary of the possible activities which may be included in a general plan, pursuant to the city manager's letter of 1-31-92.

Existing information on possible activities includes results of a general survey conducted by the PRC in 1991 and input already received by the PRC. The sub-committee recognized a lack of information from individual citizens; the bulk of input received to date is from special interest groups (soccer and softball leagues, theatrical groups, etc..) Input from individuals will complement the existing input and provide the Council with a better representation of public opinion.

The sub-committee will take the follow steps to get the desired input from individual citizens:

1. Two public meeting will be held. Objective will be to receive public comment.

2. A press release will be drafted and distributed to the Pilot and KURY radio. The press release will:

- announce the public meetings
- explain what the input will be used for, how, and when
- tell where written input can be directed
