

Troutdale, Oregon

The council of the town of Troutdale, being in regular session with Mayor Arthur H. Matches, Recorder J. Overstad, and Councilmen Charles Abbott, A. Tiller, Jess Grinnell, Lew Howell, William Lewis and Orville Riveness, all present, and councilmen _____, and none absent; councilman William Lewis moved the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the town of Troutdale, a municipal corporation, has been functioning as a municipal corporation since its corporation, October 2, 1907, without a charter; and

WHEREAS, the council deems it advisable to submit to the legal voters of said town of Troutdale a proposed municipal charter, and in pursuance thereof has authorized the preparation of a charter bearing date the month of May, 1942; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a special election be called to vote upon said proposed charter as submitted to the legal voters of said town of Troutdale;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the council of the town of Troutdale submit to the legal voters of the town of Troutdale on Monday the 24 th day of August, 1942, a proposal to adopt the charter as prepared under the supervision of the council of the town of Troutdale and which said proposed charter bears date of May, 1942;

Be it further resolved that a copy of said proposed charter be delivered either by mail or in person to each and every legal voter now residing within the corporate limits of the town of Troutdale, and that said copies of said proposed charter be delivered to said legal voters not less than 10 days prior to the date herein set for voting upon the acceptance or rejection of said proposed charter.

Be it further resolved that the voting place for the purpose of voting upon said proposed charter be in the City Hall in the town of Troutdale and that the hours for voting upon said charter be fixed between the hours of 1:00 P. M. and 7:00 P. M. of said day, and that Mrs J. Overstad and Mrs A. H. Matches be and they are hereby appointed as judges, and Mrs C. Abbott Mrs J. Grinnell and Mrs C. Parsons be and they are hereby appointed clerks of said election.

Said resolution was duly seconded by councilman C. Abbott, and upon the council being polled it was found that councilmen Charles Abbott, A. Tiller, Jess Grinnell, Lew Howell, William Lewis and Orville Riveness had voted in favor of said resolution, and that No votes had been cast in opposition thereto.

A majority of the councilmen having voted in favor of said resolution the same was declared adopted, and in attestation thereof the Mayor and Recorder have hereto fixed their signatures
