RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER, TO BE KNOWN AS CHAPTER XI, PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF THE TERRITORY INCLUDED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE TO RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NUMBER 40, MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON, AND FOR MAKING SAID TERRITORY A PART OF SAID DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF FURNISHING FIRE PROTECTION TO THE INHABITANTS OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE, FOR THE CANCELLATION OF EXISTING FIRE PROTECTION CONTRACTS UPON SUCH ANNEXATION AND FOR PRO-RATED PAYMENT THEREON.

WHEREAS, under Oregon law as recently amended it is now possible for the territory within the Town of Troutdale to become a part of Rural Fire Protection District Number 40; and

WHEREAS, Troutdale does not have an organized fire department and has previously contracted with that district for fire protection and paid a negotiated price for this service; and

WHEREAS, becoming a part of said Fire District would allow the citizens of Troutdale to vote in Fire District Elections and exercise a measure of control of Fire District policies, which rights are not available now; and

WHEREAS, Troutdale is adjacent to the boundary of said Fire District;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE, that a special election is hereby called to be held in the Town of Troutdale on the 14th day of November, 1961, at which time there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the Town of Troutdale for adoption or rejection, a proposed amendment to the Charter of the Town of Troutdale of 1942, which said amendment is to be a new Chapter designated as Chapter XI, and said amendment to be so submitted shall be as follows:

CHARTER AMENDMENT

PROPOSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL AND REFERRED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID TOWN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

That the Charter of the Town of Troutdale of 1942, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following Chapter:

CHAPTER XI

From the effective date of this Charter Amendment the territory included within the boundaries of the Town of Troutdale as presently constituted and as they may be hereafter modified is hereby declared to be annexed to Rural Fire Protection District Number 40 of Multnomah County, Oregon, and said territory is hereby made a part of said District for the purpose of providing fire protection to the inhabitants of the Town of Troutdale. Any existing fire protection contracts

in existence between said District and the Town of Troutdale shall be cancelled and terminated as of the effective date of this Charter Amendment and the charges and payments thereon shall be pro-rated. The Common Council of the Town of Troutdale is hereby empowered to do all acts and things necessary or in its discretion deemed advisable to facilitate and carry out said annexation. This Charter Amendment shall become effective upon approval of said annexation by said Fire District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE that said amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the Town of Troutdale with the following ballot title:

CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS
BY THE COMMON COUNCIL

Shall the Charter of the Town of Troutdale of 1942 be amended adding Chapter XI, providing for annexation of the territory within the boundaries of Troutdale to Rural Fire Protection District Number 9, Multnomah County, Oregon; for making said territory part of said district for the purpose of providing fire protection to inhabitants of Troutdale; for cancellation of existing fire protection contracts upon such annexation and for pro-rated payment thereon; empowering the Common Council to carry out said annexation; such amendment to become effective upon approval of annexation by said Fire District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE that the election precinct for said special election shall be and constitute all of the territory within the city limits of the Town of Troutdale and that there shall be one polling place for said election, namely, in the City Hall, Kibling and Columbia Highway, Troutdale, Oregon, at which polling place all legal voters shall vote, and which polling place shall be open from 1:00 o'clock P.M. to 7:00 o'clock P.M., Oregon Standard Time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE that the following named persons, all legal voters of the Town of Troutdale, are hereby designated and appointed as chairman and clerks of election, to act as the election board at such polling place, and on such date:

and that the Town Recorder is hereby empowered to appoint one or more substitute persons to fill vacancies occurring in said election board, who shall be legal voters of Troutdale.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE that the Recorder of the Town of Troutdale is hereby empowered and ordered to make all other arrangements and to secure the necessary supplies for such special election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE that the Recorder of the Town of Troutdale is hereby directed to give at least ten (10) days notice of the special election hereby called by posting notices thereof in not less than four public places within the boundaries of the Town of Troutdale, there being no newspaper published in the Town of Troutdale. The said notice shall be in the following form:

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

On the 14th day of November, 1961, in the Town of Troutdale, Oregon from 1:00 o'clock P.M. to 7:00 o'clock P.M., Oregon Standard Time, a special election will be held at which a charter amendment will be submitted to the legal voters of the Town of Troutdale for their approval or rejection.

The following is the ballot title, the numbers and form in which the question will be printed on the official ballot:
