

RESOLUTION - 1960

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE AN AMENDMENT TO THE CHARTER, TO BE KNOWN AS CHAPTER XI, PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ADDITIONAL WATER STORAGE, PIPING, PUMPING, PROCESSING AND SUPPLY FACILITIES FOR THE WATER SYSTEM OF TROUTDALE, TOGETHER WITH APPURTENANCES CONVENIENT THERETO, FOR ACQUISITION OF LAND AND EASEMENTS THEREFOR, FOR THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN THE SUM OF NOT EXCEEDING \$ TO BE PAID BY AD VALOREM TAXES ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN, FOR A BALLOT TITLE UNDER WHICH SAID AMENDMENT SHALL APPEAR, AND CALLING AND PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION AT WHICH SAID AMENDMENT IS TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE.

WHEREAS, the Town of Troutdale is in need of additional water storage, piping, pumping, processing and supply facilities to meet the needs of its water system in an adequate manner and requests for additional connections to the system have been made, which would further increase the necessity for storage, piping, pumping, processing and supply facilities; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid the hazard of water shortages and inadequate supply, and to promote the best interests of the town and its inhabitants, it is necessary to construct and acquire additional water storage, piping, pumping, processing and supply facilities and the Town of Troutdale desires to amend its Charter in order that the power to acquire additional real property and easements, to construct and acquire additional water storage, piping, pumping, processing and supply facilities, and to issue general obligation bonds in payment therefor, and the right to levy and collect ad valorem taxes on the taxable property within the Town of Troutdale for the payment of principal and interest on said bonds may be specifically provided for.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE, that a special election is hereby called to be held in the Town of Troutdale on the            day of            , 19    , at which time there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the Town of Troutdale for adoption or rejection, a proposed amendment to the Charter of the Town of Troutdale of 1942, which said amendment is to be a new Chapter designated as Chapter XI, and said amendment to be so submitted shall be as follows:

CHARTER AMENDMENT

PROPOSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL AND REFERRED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID TOWN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

That the Charter of the Town of Troutdale of 1942, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following Chapter:

## CHAPTER XI

In addition to the other methods provided by the Charter of the Town of Troutdale or the General Laws of the State of Oregon, and not in derogation of any of such powers, the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale, where in its discretion it is deemed advisable, may provide by resolution or resolutions for the acquisition and construction, either by contract method or city construction method, or by a combination of both, of additional water storage, piping, pumping, processing and supply facilities within or without the city limits of the Town of Troutdale, together with all the appurtenances necessary for the completion and operation of said facilities, and for such purposes may acquire by gift, purchase or condemnation, the necessary lands and easements therefor, either within or without the city limits of the Town of Troutdale; and to pay the costs thereof, the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale is hereby authorized to issue not to exceed \$            in general obligation bonds of the Town of Troutdale which shall be paid by an ad valorem tax on all taxable property within the corporate limits of said Town of Troutdale.

The Common Council of the Town of Troutdale each year shall provide in the budget for sufficient funds to pay the principal and interest on said general obligation bonds of the Town of Troutdale, which taxes shall be in addition to all other taxes permitted by the Charter of the Town of Troutdale and the laws of the State of Oregon. Said bonds shall be exempt from any limitation upon indebtedness contained in the Town Charter or otherwise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE that said amendment shall be submitted to the voters of the Town of Troutdale with the following ballot title:

Shall the Charter of the Town of Troutdale of 1942 be amended adding Chapter XI, authorizing the Common Council to construct and acquire additional water storage, piping, pumping, processing and supply facilities, and appurtenances convenient thereto, acquire lands and ease-

ments therefor; issue general obligation bonds in an amount not exceeding \$        to be paid by an annual ad valorem tax on all taxable property in addition to all other taxes now permitted, and provide annually in the Town budget for sufficient funds to pay the bond principal and interest.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE that the election precinct for said special election shall be and constitute all of the territory within the city limits of the Town of Troutdale and that there shall be one polling place for said election, namely, in the City Hall, Kibling and Columbia Highway, Troutdale, Oregon, at which polling place all legal voters shall vote, and which polling place shall be open from 1:00 o'clock P.M. to 7:00 o'clock P.M., Oregon Standard Time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE that the following named persons, all legal voters of the Town of Troutdale, are hereby designated and appointed as chairman and clerks of election, to act as the election board at such polling place, and on such date:

and that the Town Recorder is hereby empowered to appoint one or more substitute persons to fill vacancies occurring in said election board, who shall be legal voters of Troutdale.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE that the Recorder of the Town of Troutdale is hereby empowered and ordered to make all other arrangements and to secure the necessary supplies for such special election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE that the Recorder of the Town of Troutdale is hereby directed to give at least ten (10) days notice of the special election hereby called by posting notices thereof in not less than four public places within the boundaries of the Town of Troutdale, there being no newspaper published in the Town of Troutdale. The said notice shall be in the following form:

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

On the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 19\_\_\_\_, in the Town of Troutdale, Oregon, from 1:00 o'clock P.M. to 7:00 o'clock P.M., Oregon Standard Time, a special election will be held at which a charter amendment will be submitted to the legal voters of the Town of Troutdale for their approval or rejection.

The following is the ballot title, the numbers and form in which the question will be printed on the official ballot:
