

RESOLUTION No. 3 '68

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale is contemplating a local improvement program consisting of the construction of a sanitary sewer system through the City of Troutdale.

The improvement is to be financed by assessments against benefited properties.

The locations of the sewers to be constructed are described as follows:

1. Along Kibling Street from 5th Street to Columbia Blvd.
2. Along 2nd Street from Kibling Street east 200 feet.
3. Along the east-west center line of Block 5, Troutdale Addition from Kibling Street 100 feet east to center of block.
4. Along 3rd Street from Kibling Street east Sandy Street, thence south along Sandy Street to a point opposite the northeast corner of Lot 6, Block 13, Troutdale Addition.
5. Along Harlow Street from Columbia Boulevard to 8th Street; thence west along 3rd Street to Dora Street.
6. Along Dora Street from Columbia Boulevard to 8th Street.
7. Along Columbia Boulevard from 100 feet east of Kibling Street to the West line of Section 25.
8. Along Kendall Street from 2nd Street to Columbia Boulevard.
9. Across private property from Columbia Boulevard 617 feet west of the center line of Duxton Road south to 4th Street, 612 feet west of the center line of Duxton Road; thence east along 4th Street to Duxton Road.
10. Along Duxton Road from Columbia Boulevard south to Cherry Park Road; thence west along Cherry Park Road to N. E. 262nd Avenue (Hansley Road); thence south along 262nd Avenue to the southeast corner of Lot 13, Troutdale Park.
11. Along the east-west center line of Block 17, Troutdale Addition from Duxton Road east to the northwest corner of Lot 6, Block 17.
12. Along 5th Street from Duxton Road to Dora Street.
13. Along 7th Street from Duxton Road west to Kings Byway; thence south along Kings Byway to Cherry Park Road.
14. Along Martine Court from Duxton west to end.
15. Along Kendall Court from Cherry Park Road south to end.
16. Along a north projection of Harlow Street from Columbia Boulevard north to the north line of the railroad right-of-way.

All benefited property within 125 feet of the sanitary sewer or the public right-of-way containing the sanitary sewer will be included in the boundaries of the district to be assessed.

The Council will hear and consider objections or remonstrances to the proposed improvement by any parties aggrieved thereby at the regular meeting of the council at 7:30 P.M., January 14, 1969, at the City Hall.

The City Recorder is directed to make public this resolution by posting and publishing at least 10 days prior to January 14, 1969.
