

WHEREAS, Chapter 634, Oregon Laws 1969, provides as follows:

Section 1. The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820 and 471.805 shall disburse such funds in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants, according to the most recent federal decennial census, only if he reasonably is satisfied that the city meets the requirements set out in section 2 of this Act, or if the city provides four or more of the following municipal services:

- (1) Police protection.
- (2) Fire protection.
- (3) Street construction, maintenance and lighting.
- (4) Sanitary sewers.
- (5) Storm sewers.
- (6) Planning, zoning and subdivision control.
- (7) One or more utility services.


Section 2. In the year in which any city is first incorporated and the following two years it shall be considered a city for the purposes of ORS 323.455, 366.820 and 471.805 if the city charter gives the city power to provide four or more of the municipal services enumerated in section 1 of this Act.

WHEREAS, city officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities pursuant to Chapter 634, Oregon Laws 1969; now, therefore,


