

RESOLUTION NO 15

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale is contemplating a local improvement program consisting of the construction of a gravity sanitary sewer line and a domestic water line along the southerly frontage road of I-80N from Graham Road West approximately 3200 feet and a sewage pump station and pressure main to pump the sewage collected within the proposed local improvement district to the Troutdale sewage treatment plant.

The improvement is to be financed by individual assessments against benefited properties.

All benefited property abutting the proposed waterline and gravity sewer line will be included in the boundaries of the district to be assessed.

The approved engineers report is on file with the City Recorder and may be examined by the public during normal business hours.

The council will hear and consider objections or remonstrances to the proposed improvement by any parties aggrieved thereby ~~at the~~ at a meeting of the council at 7:30 P.M. May 4, 1971, at the City Hall.


The City Recorder is directed to make public this improvement by posting notice of it at the City Hall and at two places within the benefited area and by mailing copies of such notice to the owners to be assessed for the costs of such improvement. Notice shall be mailed and posted at least 10 days prior to the public hearing on the proposed improvement.


