

RESOLUTION 21

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City of Troutdale, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, that the act of the Mayor and Recorder of the said City of Troutdale, in signing an agreement in writing dated March 31, 1971, between OREGON-WASHINGTON RAILROAD & NAVIGATION COMPANY, and its Lessee, UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY, collectively, and the said CITY OF TROUTDALE, under the terms of which said City is licensed and permitted, for the consideration and subject to the terms of said agreement to construct, and thereafter during the term thereof, to maintain and operate a twelve (12) inch welded steel overhead water main attached to Bridge No. 15.60 over the right of way and roadbed and track or tracks of the said Companies, in the location indicated in said agreement, at Troutdale, Multnomah County, Oregon, and initialing the following changes to said agreement, to-wit:

g.s.c. Section 1 - "Insofar as it may lawfully do so"; has been inserted.

g.s.c. Section 9 - "underneath" has been deleted and the word "over" substituted therefor.

g.s.c. Section 5 - "and over and across the same" has been deleted.

g.s.c. Section 13 - "or protection" has been inserted following the word "support", (in two instances).
