

RESOLUTION NO. 22

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale is contemplating a local improvement program consisting of the construction of a sanitary interceptor sewer, pump station and force main to serve the area west of Beaver Creek.

The improvement is to be financed by connection charges, Federal Grant and two types of individual assessments against benefited properties.

The approved engineer's report is on file with the City Recorder and may be examined by the public during normal business hours.

The council will hear and consider objections or remonstrances to the proposed improvement by any parties aggrieved thereby at the regular meeting of the council at 7:30 P.M., Friday, September 10, 1971, at the City Hall.

The City Recorder is directed to make public this resolution by posting and publishing at least 10 days prior to the hearing.


