BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The final plans, specifications, and cost estimates for the Beaver Creek interceptor sewer, major pumping station and force main to serve the area west of Beaver Creek and to pump the sewage collected from the Local Improvement District 3-71 to the Troutdale sewage treatment plant, are found to be consistent with preliminary plans and cost estimates in the Engineer's Report and are hereby approved and adopted.



Passed by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale, this 26th day of October 1971.


