

RESOLUTION NO. 25

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale is contemplating a local improvement program consisting of the construction of a sanitary sewer, pump station and force main to serve the area in Troutdale along Sandy Boulevard.

The improvement is to be financed by connection charges and two types of individual assessments against benefited properties.

All benefited property owners within 125 feet of the sanitary sewer or the public right-of-way containing the sanitary sewer which serves their property will be assessed.

The approved engineer's report is on file with the City Recorder and may be examined by the public during normal business hours.

The council will hear and consider objections or remonstrances to the proposed improvement by any parties aggrieved thereby at the regular meeting of the council at 7:30 P.M., Tuesday, ~~November~~ 7th, 1971, at the City Hall.

The City Recorder is directed to make public this resolution by posting and publishing at least 10 days prior to the hearing.
