

RESOLUTION NO. B 43

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale is contemplating a local improvement program consisting of the construction of a gravity sanitary sewer line called the 257th Street Trunkline. It consists of a sewer continuing southerly from the existing line on N.E. 262nd, then westerly along N.E. Hensley Road, and then southerly along N.E. 257th to the intersection of N.E. 257th and S.E. Stark Street.

The boundary of the Local Improvement District, the service area, and properties assessed is shown on attached Figure 1. The assessment information is shown in Table A.

The council has heard and considered objections or remonstrances to the proposed improvement by parties aggrieved thereby, at a special hearing and as a result of the hearing held at 7:30 p.m., April 18, 1972, the engineer's report shall be revised to include the following changes:

When these revisions have been made, the engineer's report shall be adopted.

Local Improvement District, the 257th Street Trunkline, #1-72 is hereby created for this project.

The firm of CH2M/Hill is hereby directed to prepare detailed plans, specifications and cost estimates for the improvements contained in the engineering report. Final review of the plans, specifications and cost estimate shall be June 6, 1972.
