

RESOLUTION NO. 53

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THOMAS R. KELLY. A POLICE OFFICER OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, OREGON. TO SUBMIT A FORMAL APPLICATION FOR A FEDERAL GRANT UNDER THE COLUMBIA REGION ASSOCIATION OF GOVERNMENTS, THE FUNDS FROM WHICH GRANT ARE TO BE USED TO PURCHASE POLICE EQUIPMENT AND TO INITIATE VARIOUS POLICE PROGRAMS, BOTH OF WHICH ARE NECESSARY FOR FOR EFFICIENT LAW ENFORCEMENT IN THE CITY OF TROUTDALE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

That Thomas R. Kelly, a police officer of the City of Troutdale, is hereby granted authority to submit a formal application for a federal grant of funds under the Columbia Region Association of Governments. The funds are to be used for two general purposes:

- 1) To purchase police equipment in the name of the City of Troutdale, which equipment is necessary for efficient law enforcement within the City of Troutdale;
- 2) To initiate and perpetuate police programs which programs are necessary for efficient law enforcement within the City of Troutdale.
