

RESOLUTION 60 - 73

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale Local Improvement District 1-73 consists of a project for the construction of a sewage pump station, force main and gravity trunkline. The work consists of constructing two sewers: one running west on West Columbia Street, the other running east on West Columbia Street to a lift station located near the Union Pacific Railroad overpass. The gravity sewage collected will be pumped about 900 feet to the south into the Edgefield Interceptor on Halsey Boulevard.

The City having heard and considered objections to the formation of Local Improvement District 1-73 did exclude the Lawrey and Brander properties. The Local Improvement District covering the remainder of the areas benefited is hereby formed.

The Engineer is requested to assist the City in receiving bids on 27 February 1973 at 7:30 P.M. Prequalified proposals will be received based on the contract documents filed with the City for the West Columbia Trunk Sewer and dated February 1973.
