

RESOLUTION NO: 61 - 73

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale is contemplating a local improvement program consisting of the construction of a well pump station, a 0.7 million gallon reservoir, 3700 feet of transmission main and a telemetry control system to serve the area in Troutdale generally south of Cherry Park Road.

The improvement is to be financed by connection charges and an area assessment against benefited properties.

All benefited property owners in the City of Troutdale in the following general area shall be assessed.

1. All area south of Stark Street.
2. All area between the bluff on the west bank of the Sandy River and a line formed by the extension of the west property lines of those parcels adjacent to 257th Avenue between Stark Street and the south line of Sections 25 and 26 IN. 3E.
3. Platted subdivisions with watermains installed shall be excluded.
4. Property located adjacent to an existing watermain with a residential dwelling will be exempted one acre from assessment.
5. Other property to be included shall be as follows:

The approved engineer's report is on file with the City Recorder and may be examined by the public during normal business hours.

The council will hear and consider objections or remonstrances to the proposed improvement by any parties aggrieved thereby at the ~~Special~~ meeting of the council at 7:30 P.M., 17th day of, April     , 1973, at the City Hall.

The City Recorder is directed to make public this resolution by posting and publishing at least 10 days prior to the hearing.
