

RESOLUTION NO. 67- 73

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

The City of Troutdale is contemplating a local improvement program consisting of the construction of a well pump station, a 1.0 million gallon reservoir, 3200 feet of transmission main, ^{3600 feet of} and a telemetry control system to serve the area in Troutdale ^{distribution} generally south of Cherry Park Road.

The improvement is to be financed by connection charges, an area assessment against benefited properties, and a frontage assessment against property adjacent to a transmission main. ^{4 du}

The specific boundary is shown in Exhibit A of the Engineer's Report. Benefited property owners in the City of Troutdale in the following general area shall be assessed.

1. All Property south of Stark Street.
2. All Property in Section 35, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian.
3. All Property in Section 36, Township 1 North, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian.
4. Tax Lots 48, 21, 27 in Section 26, 1 North Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian.
5. Tax Lots 71 and 14 in Section 25, 1 North Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian.

Platted Subdivisions with watermains installed shall be excluded. Property located adjacent to an existing watermain with a residential dwelling will be exempted one acre from assessment.

The approved engineer's report is on file with the City Recorder and may be examined by the public during normal business hours.

The council will hear and consider objections or remonstrances to the proposed improvement by any parties aggrieved thereby at a special meeting of the council at 7:30 P.M., _____, May 29th 1973, at the City Hall.

The City Recorder is directed to make public this resolution by posting and mailing to affected property owners at least 10 days prior to the hearing.
