BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE THAT:

BE IT RESOLVED WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Troutdale finds that the designated speed of 55 miles per hour is too great a speed to be permitted on County roads within the city limits of the City of Troutdale.

WHEREAS, previous requests have been made to the County Road Department, and no action has been taken by them as a result of such a request.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Troutdale City Council, requests the Multnomah County Commissioners to direct the road department, to place designated speed signs on the area of Troutdale Road between Stark Street and Cherry Park Road and Cherry Park Road and 242nd Drive to be posted at 35 miles per hour.


