

RESOLUTION 87

A RESOLUTION SETTING FOR THE OBJECTION TO THE DISCONTINUING THE SERVICE PROVIDED BY EDGEFIELD MANOR AND CLOSING OF THE FACILITY-

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Multnomah Board of County Commissioners has stated the eminent closing of Edgefield Manor; and

WHEREAS, the residents of this facility are generally senior citizens without family; and

WHEREAS, many have lived in this facility for a long period of time and regard it is their home providing them with care and friends of long standing; and


WHEREAS, moving these senior citizens can be a traumatic ordeal for them; and

WHEREAS, closing the facility will reduce anticipated revenue from budgeted city materials and services provided by the city; and


WHEREAS the city is concerned about the vacant buildings that will be left upon subject to policing problems; therefore:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE HAS CAREFULLY CONSIDERED THE CONSEQUENCES OF CLOSING EDGEFIELD MANOR AND OPPOSES THIS PLAN OF CLOSURE AT THIS TIME AND IN THIS MANNER AND REQUESTS THE MATTER BE RECONSIDERED; AND THIS RESOLUTION BE FORWARDED TO THE MULTNOMAH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.
