

RESOLUTION No. 101

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE NEED FOR A STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF GRAHAM ROAD AND THE SOUTH FRONTAGE ROAD OF I-80 NORTH FREEWAY WITHIN THE INCORPORATED LIMITS OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE.

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale finds that an unnecessary number of heavy trucks have used the streets and roadways by the City of Troutdale causing safety hazards to the citizens of the City of Troutdale and noise disturbances, and

WHEREAS, The City of Troutdale finds that much of the aforesaid traffic has resulted from the failure of truck drivers to find the correct route to the Huskie Service Station after existing the I-80 North Freeway, and


WHEREAS, It is the belief of the Common Council of the City of Troutdale that the placing of a stop sign at Graham Road at the intersection of the frontage road on the south side of the I-80 North Freeway stopping South bound traffic would materially improve the ability of the truck drivers to observe the correct route to the Huskie Service Station,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE that this resolution be formal request to the Highway Department of the State of Oregon for the placement of the stop sign at the intersection of Graham Road and frontage road on the South side of the I-80 North Freeway within the City of Troutdale, State of Oregon, such that South-bound traffic will be stopped at the aforesaid intersection.
