

RESOLUTION #104

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE LIMITED EMERGENCY CREATED BY THE FREQUENCY OF REPAIR OF THE POLICE VEHICLE AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TRANSFER OF FUNDS TO PURCHASE A NEW POLICE VEHICLE.

WHEREAS, the frequency of repair and operating inefficiency of the City's only police vehicle has caused Troutdale Police services to periodically go out of service.

WHEREAS, the reliability of the Police vehicle presents a potential hazard to Police officers,

WHEREAS, considerably reduced cost can be achieved by joining the annual bid pool of Police agencies for new police vehicles and whereas the pool can be joined by the City no later than April 1, 1976,

WHEREAS, the purchase price of the new police vehicle is under \$5,000 and therefore the limited bid process followed complies with the State of Oregon, Public Contracts Law,

WHEREAS, the phone poll of the Council authorized the submittal of a bid by the City Administrator,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

That the City Recorder/ City Treasurer is authorized to transfer Contingency Fund appropriations in the amount of \$4703.83 to the Police Department budget to purchase a 1976 Pontiac LeMans with complete Police package options per the specifications in the State of Oregon Contract Release Order #113769 dated 2-13-76.

That this Resolution does not in any way allow the usage of the said transferred funds for any other intention than that stated in this Resolution.
