

RESOLUTION No. 108

A RESOLUTION TO RECOMMEND NAMING THE NEW REYNOLDS DISTRICT HIGH SCHOOL, TROUTDALE HIGH SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, community identity and pride closely involves both the local city government and the school district; and

WHEREAS, the community and location of existing high schools named Sam Barlow, Centennial and Reynolds are often unknown even to area residents; and

WHEREAS, the name Troutdale is both of historical and location significance to the area; and

WHEREAS, the residents of Troutdale will bear the largest portion of the tax burden; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the students will come from Troutdale; and

WHEREAS, the name Troutdale would identify student academic and athletic achievements with their community;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Troutdale that the new high school of the Reynolds School District to be located in Troutdale should be named by the Reynolds School District as TROUTDALE HIGH SCHOOL.


