

SPECIAL BUDGET MEETING  
July 20, 1977

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sturges at 7:30 p.m.  
on Wednesday, July 20, 1977.

The amount of the City of Troutdale's share of the state revenue  
is \$13,500.

3) repair of streets 4) replacement of city equipment  
5) Parks

The Mayor felt that it could not be used on capital improvements.  
The funds could be used for projects if they employ people.

Commissioner Kaiser asked if street lighting could be paid with  
these funds.

Commissioner Cox asked about using some of the funds for the  
Depot Park. Mr. Murphy said it could be used for funding for  
paving the Depot Park.

Mr. Whisenant asked about improving the parking across from the  
Brass Rail.

Mr. Murphy said the funds could be used for buying equipment.

Mrs. Hoover asked about applying the monies for drainage in  
other parts of the city than just those along the main street.

Motion moved by Mrs. Hoover that the following recommendations  
be submitted to the City Council: Seconded by H. Althaus


- 1) City Hall repair
- 2) Street sewer
- 3) Street maintenance
- 4) replacement of municipal equipment
- 5) park improvement
- 6) Park & Ride at Depot Park
