

MINUTES  
TROUTDALE CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
JULY 5, 1983 - 7:00 P.M.

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 P.M.

Pam Christian reported that she had met with the Boundary Commission and the County Counsel on Friday and discussed the need for the remonstrance measure to be on the August 9, 1983 ballot. Counsel developed a staff report recommending a call for election on August 9, 1983.

This was the only item on the County Commissioner's agenda for today's informal meeting. The County Commissioners called for an August 9 election. The ballot question is "Shall the City of Troutdale be annexed into the Mid-County Lighting District?".

Paul Thalhofer asked if there was any information on whether it will be a mail-in ballot. Pam said that it is about 99% sure, the only problem would be if a joint district were to file a measure, a joint district being one that is in two counties.

The Council discussed setting a date for an informal meeting of interested persons to get information about street lighting out to the people. Consensus was to meet July 11 at 7:00 p.m. The Mayor asked Pam to call the absent Council members and Budget Committee and advise them of the meeting.

Ron Burgin made a motion to adjourn. Paul Thalhofer seconded the motion. Ayes 4 Nays 0.


The meeting was adjourned at 7:13 P.M.
