Sanderson reviewed the staff report contained in the packet.

Councilor Kight asked if the sewer was on Strebin?

Sanderson stated no, they would have to install a line down Strebin onto Viewpoint Drive to connect.

Councilor Kight asked if they would have to pay for the entire line?

Sanderson stated yes.

Councilor Kight asked if there is water on Strebin?

Sanderson stated there is.

Sercombe cautioned the Council that this is a Quasi-Judicial hearing and outlined the procedures.

The Council expressed that there has been no ex-parte contact or conflicts of interest.

Ana Ionesi explained that they could not afford to build the type of house that would fit the neighborhood if they have to pay for the sewer extension. The neighbors have not allowed them to use the easements to cross their property.

Melvin Classen stated that he is not willing to allow use of an easement across his yard because he has just finished putting in his yard, 15-20 truckloads of dirt, sprinkler system, fence and extensive landscaping. His neighbors have the same concerns. Hopes that they build a house that will fit the neighborhood and not hurt the property values.

Mayor Thalhofer closed the public hearing and reconvened the Council Meeting at 8:00 p.m.

8. PUBLIC HEARING/ORDINANCE INTRODUCTION: An Ordinance amending the Troutdale Development Code Chapter 9, Off-Street Parking and Loading.

Mayor Thalhofer called this item, recessed the Council meeting and opened the public hearing at 8:01 p.m.

Sanderson reviewed the staff report contained in the packet.

Mayor Thalhofer asked if the development on Troutdale Road by Skyland Pub would be affected by this?

Sanderson explained that it would not.

Mayor Thalhofer closed the public hearing and reconvened the Council Meeting at 8:10 p.m.

Councilor Kight stated that he went on a ride along with the Police and recommenced it to others on the Council. Stated that the booking facility in Gresham is a big time saver, rather then having to go all the way downtown Portland.

Councilor Regelein stated that he also went on a ride along and encouraged others to take advantage of the opportunity.
