#### 1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE, ROLL CALL, AGENDA UPDATE

Mayor Thalhofer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and called on Councilor Lloyd to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Recorder Martinez called the roll.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mayor Thalhofer called this item.

Sharron Kelly, Multnomah County Commissioner updated the council on issues she has been working on, one stop career centers, poverty level and demographics in East County and providing services to these people, smart jails and the efforts being made to deal with inmates with addictions, mental, or physical problems.

 RESOLUTION: A Resolution Establishing the City's Position Regarding the Closure of Exit 16B and Rescinding Resolution No. 1075.

Mayor Thalhofer called this item.

Galloway review the staff report contained in the packet and introduced Jeff Kaiser and David Lewallen of ODOT, and Larry Nicholas of Multnomah County.

Kaiser stated that since the last meeting ODOT has met with M/C and has had several discussions on the suggestions the Council offered, based on this we have developed an agreement, for in exchange for Troutdale lifting it's resolution opposing closure of 16B, that ODOT and M/C, in partnership, will make a commitment to produce a feasibility study that would study a connection from the 238th interchange North to some point, we considered it Stark St., what I brought before you tonight is a commitment to that effect, singed by both Bruce Warner, Region One Manager for ODOT, and Larry Nicholas, for Multnomah County.

Nicholas stated that the County is very pleased to get this commitment from ODOT. The County has been taking steps in this direction for some time, this is a piece that has been missing.

Mayor Thalhofer stated that this would just commit to a study it may end up that nothing is built. It may be the solution to our problem if it is built but if not we will end up with 16B closed and have no mitigation to our problem, what assurance is there that it will happen.

Kaiser stated that this has been being studied for some time but there are still some processes that it will have to go through. We recognize that there is a need for mitigation of the traffic congestion on Frontage Rd and we feel that either of the measures we brought to you at the last meeting will offset the impacts of the closure of 16B, but beyond that we also recognize that along with completion of the 207th interchange and the improvements to 223rd interchange and Halsey, and the 238th interchange in place we believe there will be another entrance to Troutdale.

Council discussed this issue and favored the 238th interchange with a connection to Halsey.

Mayor Thalhofer suggested that this issue be set over until the full council could be available at the May 28th meeting.

Councilor Burger-Kimber voiced concerns that the resolution addressed interim mitigation measures for Frontage Rd. and not permanent solutions.

Kaiser stated that those would be interim until the permanent solutions are decided upon.

Galloway stated that the Frontage Rd. issue will be addressed at the June 11th meeting.

Council discussed taking action on this issue tonight.

Councilors Ripma, Thompson, Lloyd, and Burger-Kimber favored moving on this issue tonight.

**MOTION:** 

Councilor Ripma moved to adopt the resolution with the following amendments #2 renumbered to #3 and a new #2 inserted to read "That a connection to Halsey Street be included in the study." Councilor Lloyd seconded the motion.

Councilor Ripma stated that the loss of 16B is a tragedy but this may be an acceptable alternative for Troutdale.

Mayor Thalhofer expressed concerns that the entire council should be present to decide on an issue of this magnitude.
