1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE, ROLL CALL, AGENDA UPDATE

Mayor Thalhofer called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and called on Councilor Daoust to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Recorder Martinez called the roll.

CONSENT AGENDA:

Mayor Thalhofer called this item and read the Consent Agenda.

MOTION: Councilor Kight moved to accept Item 2.2 of the Consent Agenda. Councilor Regelien seconded the motion.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mayor Thalhofer called this item.

Jim Smith, Richard Brown, and John Bramblete, informed the Council of a new youth football program in the Troutdale area and asked for the communities support. The Troutdale Hawkeyes team members introduced themselves.

The Council welcomed the team and encouraged the Community to support them.

Mark Hush, Columbia Gorge Commerce Center - Colliers International, voiced concerns regarding the backfill requirements of the Public Works section of the Troutdale Municipal Code.

Mayor Thalhofer informed Hush and directed staff to place this item on the formal agenda for consideration and action.

4. PRESENTATION: Metro Traffic Relief Options Study

Mayor Thalhofer stated that this item would be rescheduled for an upcoming meeting.

 FINAL ORDER/FINDINGS OF FACT: Zone Change from Central Business District-Promenade to Community Commercial for Property located at 1208 East Historic Columbia River Highway.

Mayor Thalhofer called this item.

Sanderson reviewed the staff report contained in the packet.

Jack Glass, 1409 Historic Columbia River Highway, stated that he is looking forward to the zone change so that he can complete the project and begin operation.

Diane White, 1225 Historic Columbia River Highway, voiced concerns that the property in question is historic, unique, and is located in a city park, it is not the place for a drive-through business. Also concerned that it is a 20 year lease on the building.

Councilor Ripma asked if this had to be approved by ordinance?

Faith explained that the Development Code amendments that were effective September 12, allowed for a zone change to be approved by final order.

MOTION: Councilor Ripma moved to adopt the findings and final order. Councilor Regelein seconded the motion.

Councilor Ripma stated he appreciated White's concerns and assured her the property will be monitored, and if it becomes a problem then action will be taken.

Mayor Thalhofer stated that he also appreciated the comments and if there becomes problems adjustments can be made.

Councilor Kight sated that the property has been declining for years and feels that this is a great alternative to letting is deterierate. The change in the entry to the park will provide for an additional 9 parking spaces which is very much needed.

Councilor Daoust stated that he supports the Zone Change because it fits the criteria and the Draft Town Center Plan.

YEAS: 6 NAYS: 0 ABSTAINED: 0

Mayor Thalhofer voiced concerns that other areas along Historic Columbia River Highway should be addressed also.

Faith explained that they are in conjunction with the Town Center Plan which will be coming to the council.

COUNCIL CONCERNS AND INITIATIVES:

Mayor Thalhofer called this item.

Councilor Ripma reminded everyone of the Harvest Faire on September 27th and 28th.

Mayor Thalhofer encouraged support of the Troutdale Hawkeyes.

Councilor Daoust voiced concerns with urban coyotes and asked if he should bring it up to the M/C Animal Advisory Committee since he is the City's Representative.

Council directed Daoust to take it up with the M/C Animal Advisory Committee
