**Approval of minutes**: The May, 2016, minutes were approved with a correction that Sarah Tierney was a staff member present at the May Library Board meeting. Carolyn Wood moved to approve, Carol Jones seconded, and the minutes were approved.

Patron complaint about leaves as stated to Rita Rathkey.

#### **Shared Concerns:**

None.

#### **Library Directors' Reports:**

*Maupin* – Maupin has met their fundraising goal. Library stakeholders met with Ms. Craig regarding grant writing. Three grants were written by Ms. Craig in May. Moreover, the City of Maupin can offer tax benefits to people donating money to the new library in Maupin. Consequently, it was decided that a Foundation was not needed to offer tax write-offs to donors. Mik'Ael is comfortable with cataloging and will be certified to link records. Twenty-one kids attended a program put on by the Traveling Lantern Theater. The library is creating a YAC group – Youth Advisory Council.

*Dufur* – Sarah reported that on Thursday night Dufur's summer reading program would start. The library received a big book donation. Family Night had six people attend and Sarah was hopeful this new program would continue to grow.

*The Dalles* – The library hosted a magician as part of the summer reading program and had about 235 people in attendance. They were sprawled between the computers, bookshelves and magazines. There was a Summer Reading event held in City Park that was well attended with summer reading supplies being depleted. It looks like the new children's addition will not be finished by July 1<sup>st</sup>. A reasonable expectation would be August 1<sup>st</sup>. Dry-walling, mudding and bathroom tiling are recent activities in the construction zone.

**Old Business:** A review of the city's practice of not negotiating the administrative fee they charge the library was discussed

**New Business:** A discussion ensued concerning the Library Director's evaluation. It was decided that a former evaluation document would try to be used again if it can be found. Next April would be a good time to do the evaluation as it would give the city manager time to review it before the city completed their evaluation.

An election of Library Board of Director officers took place with Margaret Brewer being elected Chair and Carolyn Wood Vice-Chair.

**New Additions:** Rita Rathkey brought up a patron complaint about excessive dead leaves lying around. The Director stated that maintenance personnel (which the library shares with city hall and the state government building) has responded to this complaint before with the assurance that once the new children's addition is done that maintenance will move in and clean everything up including the landscaping.

Mr. Wavrunek brought up the idea about expanding the policies reviewed last year by the Library Board to Southern Wasco County Library as well as The Dalles Library. The Dufur Library, because of its unique situation of being school based, would have its policies fall within the purview of the Dufur School District. The Library Board agreed.

Financial Review: The Library Board voted to accept the financial report.

The next meeting will be held August 16<sup>th</sup> at 4:00 p.m. in The Dalles. Meeting adjourned at 5:01 pm.
