Approval of minutes: Margaret Brewer moved to approve, Carol Jones seconded, and the minutes were approved.

Library Directors' Reports:

Dufur – The Dufur Library has had some very successful reading contests for children. Some winners read over 500 minutes. The Masonic Lodge of The Dalles donated bicycles as prizes. Sarah is busy planning out the summer reading program. She has many programs planned such as yoga. Everyone participating in the summer reading program will get free tickets to the Oregon State Fair. She is also busy organizing for the Oregon Battle of the Books (OBOB) event. She is offering library skill classes and a story time. Sarah is anticipating the library will scrap the old, orange carpet and get a friendlier color.

Maupin – Valerie reported that the folks in Maupin have raised about a \$114,000 towards construction of a new library. She attended the Oregon Library Association's annual conference in April. Valerie stated that she learned a lot and was especially interested in the Embedded Professionals in the Library workshop and the programming workshops. Creating a Teen Advisory Board is high on her priority list.

Kevin Locke, a performer, pulled in 500 and 170 people at two different events, and was quite inspirational. She is using the upcoming Maupin Days event to launch her summer reading program and has many exciting activities planned such as Human Hungry Hippos. Ms. Craig has started grant writing for the new addition and they got 250 DVDs donated to their library. Valerie is putting folks that are raising money for the new library

together with The Dalles-Wasco County Library Foundation so they can look at the possibility of working together on fundraising efforts.

The Dalles – Today Griffin Construction is working on the roof of the new addition. Also, electricians are wiring the new addition and a storm drain pump and piping have been installed as a July 1st completion date is still expected. Dana was in Salem judging applications for LSTA (Library Services and Technology Act) grant submissions. Summer Reading preparation is in full force with many stimulating activities to encourage children to read.

Old Business: A review of the city's request for Library Foundation financial activity occurred.

New Business: Patrons abusing the fact that they have two library cards, Dufur and The Dalles, was discussed. Running up big fines on the Dufur card and then checking items out on The Dalles library card was the heart of the problem which Mr. Wavrunek would investigate.

Carolyn Wood asked about local history books and their status with the new children's addition. Mr. Wavrunek stated that no local history books are being weeded out of the book collection nor are their plans to do so. However, options for moving and rearranging the local history collection within the library are being evaluated.

Financial Review: Sarah asked about the Ready-to-Read grant funds and how they are spent. The Children's Librarian, Dana, will relay this information to Sarah. Carolyn Wood motioned to accept the financial statements and Margaret Brewer seconded, and the motioned was approved.

The next meeting will be held June 21th at 4:00 in The Dalles. Meeting adjourned at 5:30 pm.
