The meeting was called to order by Mayor Lawrence at 5:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

<u>Approval of Lease with Washington Department of Natural Resources for Premises Located at</u> the Columbia Gorge Regional <u>Airport</u>

City Attorney Parker reviewed the staff report.

It was moved by McGlothlin and seconded by Miller to approve the Lease with Washington Department of Natural Resources for Premises Located at the Columbia Gorge Regional Airport; and authorize the execution of the proposed lease with Klickitat County and the Washington

Department of Natural Resources, subject to approval of the proposed lease by the Klickitat County Board of Commissioners. The motion carried, Elliott absent.
