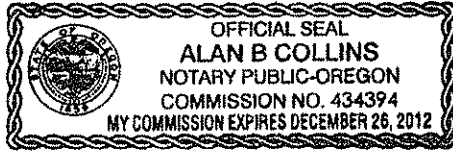

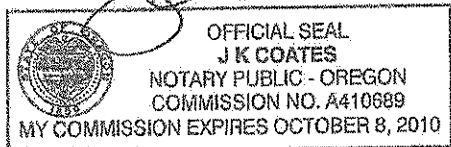

DEQ to Amend Greenhouse Gas and Particulate Pollution Rules to Align with Federal Regulations

Public hearings Nov. 16-19; Comments due Nov. 24

The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality is proposing rules that would update state regulations for fine particle pollution and greenhouse gases in order to align them with new federal regulations. These rules apply to industrial sources that qualify for federal programs called “New Source Review and Prevention of Significant Deterioration” – terms from the federal Clean Air Act that describe a set of criteria designed to prevent negative impacts to air quality when a new industrial facility is opened or an existing facility significantly upgrades or alters their operation.

This amendment will not affect the stringency of Oregon’s air quality permitting program and will allow DEQ to continue to implement the federally delegated program in Oregon.

These amendments, if adopted by the Environmental Quality Commission, DEQ’s rulemaking board, will be submitted to the EPA as a revision to the State Implementation Plan as required by the Clean Air Act. The plan is the official agreement between DEQ and EPA that describes how DEQ will manage federally delegated environmental programs and maintain compliance with standards related to air quality.
