



## Notice of Public Hearing On Proposed Air Quality Rule Amendments


The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality is proposing that the Environmental Quality Commission adopt revisions to Oregon Administrative Rule Chapter 330 Divisions 200, 210, 212, 228 and 252. The rule changes would replace technical rules filed July 22, 2011 in addition to proposing other changes affecting boilers subject to state and federal air quality regulations.

These amendments, if adopted, will be submitted to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as revisions to the State Implementation Plan (SIP) required by the Clean Air Act. DEQ will hold a public hearing on the proposed rule changes in Portland at 5:00pm, August 18, 2011, at the DEQ Headquarters Office, 811 SW 6th Avenue, Room EQC-4. Oral and written comment will be accepted at the hearing.

### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held by the Executive Director of the Oregon Facilities Authority (the "Authority") beginning at 1:15 p.m. on August 3, 2011 immediately before the Authority's monthly meeting to be held at the Eugene Public Library, Atrium Sloat Room, 1st Floor, 99 W. 10th Avenue, Eugene, Oregon 97401 with respect to the issuance of not more than \$1,610,000 aggregate face amount of tax exempt bonds (the "Bonds"), the proceeds of which will be used (a) to refinance a loan that was obtained to finance the acquisition of an approximately 5,617 square foot residential mental health treatment facility located at 3692 Hickory Avenue, Eugene, Oregon (the "Garden Place Facility"); (b) to finance the acquisition and remodeling of an approximately 29,000 square foot facility located at 499 W. 4th Street, Eugene, Oregon (the "Administrative Facility"); and (c) to pay costs of issuing the Bonds. Both the Garden Place Facility and the Administrative Facility will be initially owned and operated by ShelterCare, a non-profit organization qualified under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. ShelterCare intends to use the Administrative Facility to house ShelterCare's administrative, maintenance, and training functions, as well as to provide space to house ShelterCare's affiliated construction company and space for future tenants. Both the Garden Place Facility and the Administrative Facility will be used to further ShelterCare's charitable mission to serve families who are homeless or at risk of homelessness and adults disabled by mental illness or acquired brain injury.

The bonds will not be payable from any funds, assets or tax revenues of the Authority, the State of Oregon or any agency or instrumentality thereof. The bonds will be payable solely and only from the loan repayments to be made by ShelterCare.

Interested individuals may express their views, both orally and in writing. Oral comments at the public hearing will be limited to 10 minutes for each speaker. Written testimony may be submitted to the Oregon Facilities Authority, 1600 Pioneer Tower, 888 SW Fifth Avenue, Portland, Oregon, 97204, until the close of business on August 2, 2011, or at the hearing. This notice is published pursuant to the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and ORS 92.640


