Subject: Division 12 Rulemaking

Greetings Gentleman,

OCE has been working on its Division 12 rulemaking package for some time. We are now preparing to go out on public notice with the package in August. Division 12 prescribes DEQ's formal enforcement process and civil penalty determinations. Legislation in 2009 increased DEQ's civil penalty maximums from \$10,000 per day per violation to \$25,000 per day per violation (much more for spills!) This rulemaking package implements these new maximums, starting with an increase to base civil penalties. Here is a link to the rulemaking documents, just in case you are curious what this might entail.

So here's why I'm bugging you. The air quality program has informed OCE that they would like us to send notice of the rulemaking to not only the agency rulemaking list on GovDelivery, but also to

all of the air quality permittees and interested persons list. So, my question to you both is, are there special lists for your respective programs that you also think should receive the Division 12 notice of rulemaking (in addition to the agency rulemaking list)? If so, please let me know what those are and whether they already exist on GovDelivery, or whether we will need to do this by other means.
