colored cullet = raw material

James Knox - Norstar

- no weight threshold
- should apply nationwide
- grain loading better than 99%.

Al Fleigman - Norstar

- < 10 tons yes down to 1 lb
- should apply statewide/nationwide
- 99% public should care what's coming out of the baghouse. Grain loading good.
99% test = \$350k.
- Cd. Tier 1 have all stopped using Cd voluntarily. 65% to 85% voluntary rate.

require baghouse

- 1- def of melt / molten glass
- 2- def of kiln
- 3- def of colored glass
- 4- 1 lb threshold

process of melt should be regulated
kiln workers, lamp workers subject?

melt: process of moving to fully liquid

kiln: refractory lined vessel where raw materials
charged & brought to fully liquid state
to make new glass

colored glass should not count as raw material

unless full melt in gas furnace or ^{out gassing} raw materials
not < 10 ton, other glass processes should be regulated
in other rulemaking, if at all
