On Thursday, September 13, 2018, the Environmental Quality Commission adopted proposed rule amendments revising rules that affect quality permit fees. The affected rules are in OAR 340-045-0075 and 340-071-0800.

## Summary

The proposed rule amendments increase water quality fees for fiscal year 2019 by seven percent. These fees apply to National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permits and Water Pollution Control Facility permits. As part of this rulemaking rule amendments also increase permit fees for the municipal separate storm sewer system permits, commonly called MS4.
