

AN ORDINANCE, ACCEPTING THE IMPROVEMENT OF PARTS OF WHEELER STREET AND PACIFIC AVENUE IN WARRENTON, OREGON, AND DIRECTING THAT ASSESSMENTS BE MADE UPON THE PROPERTY THEREBY BENEFITED TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSE OF SUCH IMPROVEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Common Council having heretofore, by ordinance, authorized and directed the improvement of portions of Wheeler Street and Pacific Avenue, described as follows: Beginning on Wheeler Street, at its intersection with the center line of Portland Avenue; thence running along the center of said Wheeler Street, in a Northerly direction, to its intersection with the center line of Pacific Avenue; thence along the center line of Pacific Avenue, in a Westerly direction, to its intersection with the U.S. Meander Line on the Easterly bank of the Skipanon River; the said streets passing over parts of First Extension to East Warrenton, and of Portoria, in accordance with the duly recorded plats thereof, and being in the City of Warrenton, Clatsop County, Oregon;-- said improvement being made in the following described manner, to-wit:

AND WHEREAS, said improvement having been completed in accordance with said ordinance and the plans and specifications therefor, and a certificate of completion of said improvement having been signed by the ~~Warrenton~~ ~~Warrenton~~ ~~Warrenton~~ Committee on Streets and Public Highways, and heretofore filed with the Auditor and Police Judge, approving said improvement, from which it appears that the aggregate expense of said improvement is \$ 5846.19; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that assessments be made and levied against the real property benefited by said improvement, for the purpose of raising a special fund with which to defray the expense of making said improvement: Now, therefore,

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN, as follows:

Section 1. That the Board of Assessors, consisting of V. J. Coffey and E. H. Slagg and E. S. Hanel be, and it hereby is, authorized and directed to assess the hereinafter described property, in accordance with the benefits accruing to the same from said improvement, in the aggregate sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_, the property to be so assessed and included in a special assessment district being particularly described as follows, to-wit: All of blocks numbered 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 11, 12, 15, 16, 21, 22, 26, 27, 34, 35, and lots numbered 1 and 2, in block numbered 6, in Portoria, a subdivision of the City of Warrenton, Oregon; Also all of blocks numbered 38, 39, 45 and 46 in Warren's First Extension to East Warrenton, in said City.

Section 2. That said Board of Assessors, in making said assessment, as aforesaid, shall make out a list of said lots, lands and premises, by proper description, giving the valuation of each lot or parcel of land, respectively, with the name or names of the reputed owner or owners, and shall levy thereon the amount to be assessed, in the manner provided in this ordinance and the charter of the City of Warrenton, and when said assessment shall be completed, it shall report the same to the Council, at its next regular meeting, if practicable, and, if not, then as soon thereafter as may be practicable.

Section 3. That the enactment of this ordinance at this time, and the taking effect of the same forthwith, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Warrenton, and, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor of said City.
