

Ordinance Number 100 A

An ordinance confirming special assessment roll Number 66 of the City of Warrenton, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS; The improvement of Date street from its intersection with the macadam roadway on third street; thence running south along the center of Date street to its intersection with the north line of fourth street, in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, has been completed by the Brookfield Quarry and Torage Company, a corporation, contractor, under its contract with the City of Warrenton, and

WHEREAS; Said improvement has been duly accepted by the Commission of the City of Warrenton, and a statement of the entire cost of the same, together with a description of the property benefited thereby, and the names of the owners, or reputed owners thereof, as described in the report of the committee on estimates, as adopted by the commission, and all of the costs and expenses as provided by the charter of the City of Warrenton, has been duly included in an assessment duly filed and a hearing thereon has been duly held as provided by law, and said assessment roll which is assessment roll number 66 of the City of Warrenton, Oregon, has been duly equalized and passed upon and determined and adjusted by the said commission;

Now therefore;

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1- That Assessment Roll number 66, made for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of improving Date street, from its intersection with the macadam roadway on third street, thence running south along the center of Date street to its intersection with the north line of fourth street, in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, as made and filed, determined and passed upon by the commission of the City of Warrenton, and the Board of estimates and duly equalized, and now on file and marked "Special Assessment Roll Number 66", be and the same is hereby confirmed

1 ,and approved, and the same is made payable on or before the
2 23^d day of June, 1925.

3 Section 2:- That after the passage and approval of this
4 ordinance by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton, the said
5 Assessment Roll Number 66, shall be spread upon the Docket
6 of City Liens of the City of Warrenton, Oregon, and collected
7 as provided by law.

8 Section 3:- Inasmuch as the objects to be obtained by this
9 ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City
10 of Warrenton, and there is an urgent necessity that this ordinance
11 take effect as soon as possible, so that the credit of the
12 City of Warrenton may be maintained, and so that the health, peace
13 and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton may be preserved
14 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this section
15 therefore shall take effect when approved by the affirmative
16 vote of four members of the Commission, and this ordinance shall
17 then be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and
18 approval by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton.
