3 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A SPECIAL TAX  
4 OF *10* MILLS UPON ALL THE ASSESSABLE PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF WARREN-  
5 TON, OREGON, FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATING THE SAME TO  
6 THE USES AND PURPOSES OF THE WATER COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF  
7 WARRENTON TO THE END THAT SAID COMMISSION SHALL MAKE A PRELIMINARY  
8 SURVEY AND INVESTIGATION OF THE ~~WATER~~ SUPPLY OF THE CITY OF WARREN-  
9 TON, TO PROVIDE PLANS FOR A BETTER WATER SYSTEM, AND TO ALSO IN-  
10 VESTIGATE AND PROVIDE PLANS FOR A MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC LIGHT PLANT  
11 AND SYSTEM.

12 The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows:

13 The people of the City of Warrenton do ordain as follows:

14 SECTION I: That for the purpose of making a preliminary  
15 investigation and survey of the territory adjacent to the City of  
16 Warrenton to the end that an adequate and suitable supply of water  
17 may be secured and brought into said municipality for all domestic  
18 and municipal purposes, and to provide plans for such a municipal  
19 water system, and also for the purpose of making a preliminary  
20 investigation and survey of the question of establishing a municipi-  
21 pal light plant in and for said City of Warrenton, and for all  
22 kindred purposes allied to these two main propositions, and for  
23 the purpose of generally carrying out the objects of this ordinance,  
24 a special tax of *10* mills is hereby made and levied upon all the  
25 assessable and taxable property within the City of Warrenton, both  
26 real and personal, which is taxable by law for state and county  
27 purposes; which said special tax of *10* mills shall be collected in  
28 the manner provided by law for the collection of other municipal and  
29 county taxes.

30 SECTION II: That when said tax is collected the same shall,  
31 in its entirety, be turned over to the water commission of the City  
32 of Warrenton, for the uses and purposes herein set forth and indicated;

1 and it is hereby made the duty of said water commission to make  
2 the investigations and surveys hereinbefore mentioned in Section  
3 I of this ordinance, and to utilize and apply any or all of said  
4 fund to the investigations and surveys aforesaid, and for the up=  
5 building and betterment of the water system <sup>or light plant or both.</sup> of the City of Warren-  
6 ton.

7 SECTION III: It shall be the duty of said water commission  
8 to keep strict account of said special fund, and to make detailed  
9 report unto the Common Council of the City of Warrenton at the  
10 commencement of each fiscal year of the manner in which said moneys  
11 have been expended, and of the results therefrom obtained.
