

Ordinance 1045-A

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING *ORDINANCE 183-A AND 716-A, RELATING TO FEES FOR CERTAIN AMUSEMENT DEVICES* EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 2001.

WHEREAS, after careful deliberation and consideration, the Warrenton City Commission has determined that the City Amusement Device Fee provided for in City Ordinance's 183-A and 716-A contains inherent inequities; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to abandon the practice of applying an amusement device fee within the City of Warrenton; and


WHEREAS, The City Commission finds that the amusement device fee as described in Ordinance 716-A unfairly targets a specific class of devices as a means of revenue support for the City of Warrenton;

THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 183-A and 716-A, relating to licenses for certain amusement devices, are hereby repealed

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after its passage.
