

Ordinance No. 105

An Ordinance appropriating out of a special fund constituted for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of redeeming Lot 8, Block 11 of Warrenton Addition to Astoria from a tax title made to Mrs Anna Coffey, for payment of Street Assessment No. 3, recorded in Folio 10, Docket of City Levis, against M. A. Scott; the sum of \$50 ³²/₁₀₀ in favor of Anna Coffey.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows.

Section 1. That here be and there is hereby appropriated out of a special fund constituted for the purpose of defraying the costs and expenses of redeeming Lot 8, Block 11 Warrenton addition to Astoria as recorded in Street Assessment No. 3, Folio 10, Line 1, of the Docket of City Levis against M. A. Scott, from a tax title and deed, usually against said lot, in the sum of \$27 ⁴²/₁₀₀ together with costs and expenses of sale, as follows. Interest on account ment. \$3 ²⁹/₁₀₀ Penalty, \$8 ⁵⁶/₁₀₀ Advertising \$2 ⁵⁰/₁₀₀, total \$41 ⁷⁸/₁₀₀. Also interest on \$41 ⁷⁸/₁₀₀ from March 5th 1912 to Oct. 16th 1913. \$4 ²³/₁₀₀ and taxes for 1912. levied by City County & State, against said lot, in the sum of \$4 ³¹/₁₀₀ amounting in all to \$50 ³²/₁₀₀.

Section 2. That upon the passage and approval of this ordinance the Auditor & Police Judge be and he is hereby instructed to issue a warrant for the sum of \$50 ³²/₁₀₀ in favor of Mrs Anna Coffey, in full settlement for the same.
