ORDINANCE NO. 1055-A

INTRODUCED BY COMMISSIONER: <u>Lylla Gaebel</u> AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 853-A SECTION 5 (1) AND (3)(f), REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC SEWERS; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 974-A AND ANY OTHER ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. <u>SECTION 5. (1) OF ORDINANCE NO. 853-A: USE OF PUBLIC SEWERS</u>, is amended to read as follows:

No person shall discharge or cause to be discharged any storm water, surface water, ground water, roof runoff or subsurface discharge to any sanitary sewer. Cooling water or unpolluted industrial process water may be permitted to be discharged into a specific sanitary sewer, upon approval of the public works superintendent.

And;

SECTION 2. SECTION 5. (3)(f): is amended to read as follows:

Any waters or wastes having a pH lower than 6.0 or higher than 9.0, or having any other corrosive property capable of causing damage or hazard to structures, equipment, and personnel of the sewage works.

SECTION 3. <u>VALIDITY</u>: In case any portion of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid for any reason whatsoever by any court, then all other provisions of this ordinance shall be held and considered to be independent of and separate from such invalid portions and shall not be affected or rendered void by the invalidity of such other portions.

SECTION 4. REPEAL: Ordinance No. 974-A is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after its adoption.
