

# Ordinance No 106

An Ordinance levying a special tax of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mills on each dollar upon the assessable property of the City of Warrenton for the purpose of defraying the balance of the cost of construction of the City Hall for the said City of Warrenton.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows.

## Section 1

That there be and there is hereby levied a special tax of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  mills upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of the property within the City of Warrenton, upon the Tax Roll for the year 1913, which said special tax is levied for the express purpose of defraying the balance of the cost of construction of the City Hall for the City of Warrenton.

## Section 2

That the Auditor & Police Judge be and he is hereby instructed to serve a certified copy of this ordinance, upon the County Clerk and the County Assessor of Clatsop County, Oregon, in the time required by law for that purpose.
