

ORDINANCE NO. 1098-A

Repealing Ordinance No. 1081-A  
and Declaring an Emergency

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2005, the Warrenton City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 1081-A, allowing and defining "sports pool boards" as social games in the City of Warrenton; and

WHEREAS, the City has received an opinion from the Oregon General Attorney's Office that concludes these games are not social games under ORS 167.117(21) but are considered lottery as defined in ORS 167.117 (12) and as such constitute unlawful gambling.


NOW, THEREFORE, the City Commission of the City of Warrenton Ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 1081-A is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. In order to preserve the peace, health and safety of the City, an emergency is declared and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
