

An ordinance adopting, confirming and approving estimates of budget of expenses and receipts as made and filed by the levying Board and Budget Committee, of the City of Warrenton for year 1926, levying taxes for general municipal purposes, for bond interest and sinking fund purposes and for all other purposes for the City of Warrenton, upon the 1925 tax roll, all for year 1926, and declaring ~~in~~ an emergency.

THE CITY OF WARRENTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1- That the estimates of budget of expenses and receipts as made and filed by the Levying Board and Budget Committee of the City of Warrenton for year 1926 upon the 1925 tax roll as hereto attached and made a part hereof as though set out in full herein, and all acts, matters and things had and done in connection therewith, be and the same is herewith adopted, confirmed and approved.

Section 2- That there be and is hereby levied a tax for general municipal purposes for the City of Warrenton for year 1926 upon the 1925 tax roll, ⁱⁿ the sum of \$ 27,738.02.

Section 3- That there be and is hereby levied a tax for Bond interest purposes for the City of Warrenton, for year 1926 upon the 1925 tax roll, ⁱⁿ the sum of \$ 34,544.90.

Section 4- That there be and is hereby levied a tax for sinking fund purposes for the City of Warrenton for the year 1926, upon the 1925 tax roll, ⁱⁿ the sum of \$ None Total Levy \$62,282.92

Section 5- That the said tax as aforesaid, for the City of Warrenton as specified in the estimates and budget made and filed by the Levying Board and Budget Committee of the City of Warrenton, and duly adopted by the majority of the qualified voters at tax budget meeting, held on the 29th day of October 1925 and as amended by the Commission on November 4th 1925 for year 1926 upon ~~the~~ 1925 tax roll, be and the same is hereby adopted, confirmed and approved.

2 Section 6- That all of the taxes levied as herein before
3 specified are levied upon all property, both real and personal
4 within the corporate limits of the City of Warrenton, which is
5 taxable by law for state and county purposes.

6 Section 7- Inasmuch as the object to be obtained by this
7 ordinance will be of great benefit to the people of the City of
8 Warrenton, and there exists and is an urgent necessity that this
9 ordinance should take effect as soon as possible so that the
10 health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Warrenton
11 may be preserved and so that the government of said City may
12 properly function an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and
13 this section, therefore shall take effect when approved by the
14 affirmative vote of all of the commissioners of the City of
15 Warrenton and this ordinance shall then be in full force and
16 effect and operative immediately after its passage and approval
17 by the Mayor of the City of Warrenton, passed by the Commission
