

Ordinance No. 111

An Ordinance providing for a general municipal election, to be held in the City of Warrenton, Oregon, on Wednesday December 17<sup>th</sup> 1913, and naming the Election to hold hereat.

The City of Warrenton does ordain as follows  
Section 1 That a General Municipal election for the City of Warrenton, Oregon, shall be held on Wednesday December 17<sup>th</sup> 1913, at which election shall be elected, a Mayor two Councilmen for a term of two years, and two Citizens for the term of one year.

Section 2 That the City shall be, and it is hereby designated as the place for holding said election,

Section 3 That the Clerks of said election shall be Emil Erickson and Jennice Moore, and the Judges of said election shall be V. A. Coffey, Ed. Greer, and Henry Lee.

Section 4 That V. A. Coffey shall be chairman of said Election board, and that the Polls shall open at 9 o'clock a.m. and close at 7 o'clock p.m.

Section 5 That the Auditor and Police Judge shall give notice of such election by posting such notice in three public places within the City of Warrenton for a period of at least 10 days prior to said election,

Section 6. That the Form of Ballot shall be as follows.

General Municipal Election

City of Warrenton, Oregon

Wednesday, December 17<sup>th</sup> 1913.

Instructions Mark a cross (X) before the name of the Candidate voted for, or fill in the name of the desired candidate  
Vote for One Mayor. Vote for four Councilmen

Mr. Mayor. Vote for one. One year term

Mr. Councilman. Vote for two. Two year term

Mr. Councilman. Vote for two. One year term

Section 7 If any political party shall file with the Auditor and Police Judge, a list of its nominees, as provided for under the general election laws of this State; said Auditor shall have printed a ballot to conform as closely as possible with the form above set forth, and which said ballot shall have printed thereon the list of candidates of such political party or parties, provided however that said political party or parties, shall hand in the list of their candidates to said Auditor and Police Judge at least one week prior to the date of such election.
